

TNC OVERVIEW


The Nyadire Connection (TNC), based in Pittsburgh, Pa., is a faith-based, all-volunteer, non-profit organization that seeks to support and sustain the Nyadire United Methodist Mission in northeastern rural Zimbabwe, Africa. The Nyadire Mission offers a hospital, nursing school, school system (preschool through high school), orphanage, teachers' college, farm, and many other services to the surrounding community.

TNC was founded in 2006 after a Volunteer in Mission team of 18 Pittsburghers traveled to Nyadire for three weeks. After returning from the mission trip, many felt that support to Nyadire should be ongoing and more in depth. Since then, TNC has developed partnerships and relationships among friends in the U.S., supportive Methodist churches and Nyadire, and has provided administrative, financial and spiritual support for numerous projects and ongoing programs.


HOME OF HOPE OUTREACH/ SCHOOL SPONSORSHIP

More than 500 children in and around Nyadire have been identified as orphans. This shockingly high rate is not unusual, as 25 percent of all children in Zimbabwe are orphaned. Some live in orphanages, some live with extended family, some are living on their own, leading their own households and often parenting younger siblings.

Despite these obstacles the children want to attend school because it provides a source of hope. Students must pay school fees and wear school uniforms to be allowed to attend school. Yet, in these times of economic and political hardship, many students simply cannot afford to attend school.



WHAT WE DO



The Home of Hope Outreach/School Sponsorship (HOHO) program seeks to ensure that as many orphans as possible in the Nyadire region are able to get a basic school education and learn essential life skills. In partnership with the Nyadire Mission and schools in the surrounding area, HOHO connects orphans with sponsors who assist in funding the student's education.

HOW YOU CAN HELP

By sponsoring a child, you ensure that an orphan has an opportunity to receive the gift of an education. An annual donation of \$100 covers school fees for one orphan for one year of schooling. In addition, each student receives a backpack and school supplies. Your sponsorship also allows you an opportunity to develop a relationship with your student as you exchange correspondence.
