

“Meet The Match” To Support TNC’s Clinic Rebuild Program



Based in Pittsburgh and founded in 2006, **The Nyadire Connection (TNC)** is a faith-based, all-volunteer, non-profit organization that partners with the Nyadire UM Mission in Zimbabwe. The Mission includes a hospital, which has responsibility for six rural health clinics. These **clinics serve as a critical medical care facility** for women to deliver babies and for people with infectious diseases; patients often walk many miles to a clinic. Yet, **the clinics have been in disrepair**, with no running water, flush toilets or electricity, and not enough space.

Several years ago, **TNC began a program to renovate the clinics**, in partnership with Nyadire and the Zimbabwe Ministry of Health. To date, five clinics have been rebuilt, **on-time and on-budget**. We’re now working on the final clinic, Chindenga, and we need your help. A generous couple in the Pittsburgh District have made a **challenge grant** to TNC: They will match every dollar we raise up to \$25,000, which means we can receive **\$50,000 if we “meet the match.”** The total cost of rebuilding Chindenga is \$350,000, so if we can “meet the match,” we will have made great progress. We ask you to **prayerfully consider making a tax-deductible donation to TNC**, perhaps for one of these specific clinic purposes:

- \$100 - a window frame for the Waiting Mothers' Shelter
- \$500 - 2 stainless steel sinks for the delivery room
- \$1,000 - control panel for solar-powered borehole (water well) pump
- \$5,000 - roofing materials for the OutPatient Building
- \$7,500 - drilling and casing for the borehole
- \$10,000 - labor costs to build the Maternity Ward
